

Cambridge State Bank and John T. Vucurevich Foundation pledge an additional \$50K for the new Cambridge Library

Cambridge State Bank and the John T. Vucurevich Foundation recently provided a major boost to the fundraising efforts for the new Cambridge Community Library. They have recently pledged an additional \$50,000 in support of the project. With previous donations of \$51,000, this pledge brings the total combined support from the Cambridge State Bank and the John T. Vucurevich Foundation to \$101,000.

This most recent pledge is contingent upon the Library Building Campaign reaching their fundraising goal of \$1.8 million by mid-April 2014. With this generous gift, fundraising for the project has passed the \$1.3 million mark. The new 6800 square foot library is to be built as an addition to the Amundson Center which houses the current 2100 square foot library.
