

## Jones Dairy Farm supports new library

Jones Dairy Farm of Fort Atkinson has been a good neighbor to Cambridge and recently solidified that relationship with gifts totaling \$6,000 toward the new Cambridge Community Library campaign.

The firm, celebrating its 125th anniversary this year, contributed \$5,000 toward the library campaign to push its fundraising near \$1.7 million.

Joy and Roger Borchardt added to that donation and offered a personal gift of \$1,000 toward the venture. Roger is a vice president of Jones Dairy Farm.

As of the first week in March, the new library fundraising was just about \$100,000

short of its \$1.8 million goal to triple the size of the library, scheduled for bidding soon, and a start on construction of the addition to the Amundson Center this year.

Milo Jones founded the firm in 1889 with products that are completely natural, without preservatives, fillers, binders or extenders.

In the spring, the company will launch a recipe book based on Jones products. There is a recipe contest in the summer with a grand prize of \$2,000.

It started exporting its products in 1938, shipping now to Canada, Mexico, Central America, China, Japan, Hong Kong, Taiwan, and the Middle East.
